strum

Be Kind

Process

Melody

- ✓ Teacher sings melody, Students echo by phrase.
- ✓ Show outline of chord structure

- ✓ Teacher sings root of chords.
- ✓ Teacher sings root again, Students echo.
- ✓ Students sing root, Teacher sings melody.
- ✓ Switch parts.
- ✓ Transfer chord roots to bass xylophone, sing.

Ukulele

- ✓ Display chord charts for G C D7, review fingerings.
- ✓ Students play G chord with new rhythmic strum. Brush up on beats two and four. "Air play" beats one and three.
- ✓ Repeat strum with all chords.
- ✓ All sing and play ukulele.

Hand Drum

✓ Display words for hand drum rhythm, Students patsch rhythm on legs.

Everybody, everybody, everybody Be Kind.

Everybody, everybody, everybody YES!

✓ Teacher plays hand drum, students imitate.












✓ Make two groups, one sings melody, one plays hand drum, switch parts.

Combine all ingredients and play throughout the reading of the book <u>Be Kind.</u>






Prep: Barred instruments, soprano ukuleles, shakers, low

Cook Time: 3 lessons

Degree of Difficulty: AB form, chords on ukulele (F, C7, Bb,

Dm), syncopation





Be You

Process

A Section

- ✓ Teacher sings A Section. Students echo by phrase. Students echo entire song.
- ✓ Using the words "You are wonderful. You are a star," Teacher speaks words with rhythm (shaker part). Students echo speak. Transfer to shakers.
- ✓ Make two groups. One group sings A Section, one group plays shakers. Switch parts.
- ✓ Teacher patsches Bass Xylophone rhythm and speaks "Just be yourself al-ways, yes!" Students echo speak words with rhythm. Transfer to bass xylophone on I chord (F), IV chord (Bb only), and V chord (octave C's).
- ✓ Make three groups. One group sings, one group plays shakers and one group plays bass xylophone. Switch parts.
- ✓ Create introduction with bass xylophone. Perform A section.

B Section - (lesson 2)

- ✓ Teacher sings B Section and claps low drum part.
- ✓ Teacher sings again, Students clap low drum part.
- ✓ Students echo sing by phrase (continuing claps)
- ✓ Transfer claps to low drum.
- ✓ Students echo sing entire song. Add ritardando on final three notes.
- ✓ Teacher demonstrates a roll with patchen while singing entire song. (roll on right leg for D, left leg for C) Students join. Transfer roll to bass xylophone on low D and C.
- ✓ Combine all parts. Singing group, low drum, and bass xylophone.


Lesson 3

- ✓ Teacher displays ukulele chord templates F, C7, Bb and Dmin.
- ✓ Students practice each chord, playing each chord for 8 beats, rest for 8 beats, and play the next chord for 8 beats. Continue with all chords. Reduce strum and rest beats to 6 beats, then 4 beats. This will allow students to switch chords more fluidly.
- \checkmark Display lyric sheet with chord templates. Slowly practice all chords. Add singing.
- \checkmark Gradually add all parts.
- ✓ Form ABA

Optional Ingredients

- ✓ When performing the ritardando at the end of the B Section, practice the A Section a tempo. Rehearse these tempo changes.
- ✓ Add a two-measure introduction to A Section and a 2-measure interlude from B to A.


